




German Association for Noise Prevention on Transport Routes




- Opposing unfair competition in marketing and all other variants by all possible means, as well as vigorously countering all violations against commercial practices and propriety

Believe me, we have to fight our corner and not all the compromises are consented to.

However, we believe that it is useful to sort out at least a few of these matters in advance, rather than quarrel unnecessarily during construction.

The quality of the planning, construction work and materials, as well as the guarantees are always discussed intensively.



These measures are funded from taxes.

The state requires an adequate equivalent value. It is only possible to build in accordance with technical regulations, legislation specifications and approvals.

All the materials to be used in the construction must be tested and licenced.


The durability and longevity must be guaranteed and this can only be achieved by good quality of products.




We all know that quality products are expensive, but in terms of life-cycle costings, the investment is always worth it.
